

## MATH CHAMPION Frequently Asked Questions

Thank you for being a leader in the math movement this year by partnering with EIM as a Math Champion for Make a Move for Math. We're here to help you make this a fun and engaging experience for you and your guests!

**FAQ:** Do I have to purchase a full table of 10 people to be considered a Math Champion?

**Answer:** No! You qualify as our Math Champion once you've recruited just 4 guests to join you for dinner at Make a Move for Math.

**There are 2 ways to partner with us as a Math Champion:**

- Recruit a minimum of four people to purchase tickets for *Make a Move for Math*, who identify you as their "Math Champion" when they register to attend the event.
- Host a table of 10 at *Make a Move for Math* and become eligible for our special 'Treat your Table' upgraded wine experience for your guests

**FAQ:** What is 'Treat your Table' and how do I become eligible?

**Answer:** 'Treat your Table' is a special wine upgrade exclusively available to our Math Champions this year with a full table of 10. For an additional \$250, you can treat your guests to premium wine throughout the evening.
